Ikbenfrits is an online mortgage advisor which provides access to the largest amount of Dutch banks at competitive prices.

- I improved code quality and engineering culture by introducing better code review processes and enforcing CI/CD way of working.
- I organized hackathon projects to increase team's cohesiveness and engagement.
- I managed a team that worked on re-architecting core data storage system and developing GraphQL API around it.
- I have rebuilt an interest rate search component. The rebuild was done by running two systems in parallel. As a result, we reduced response time in half.

- I designed an integration between Nxchange and ABN AMRO to perform live cash settlements over blockchain network.

Movinga removes stress from moving. The company is doing so by creating a marketplace where movers meet transportation companies.

- I build an API to server visual backend interface for moving companies that was used to track available orders in our system.
- I have designed dispatching system that was generating a weekly schedule for moving companies. It was providing point to point route that was optimized with highest possible utilization of the truck.
